"For us veterans and thousands of our families, what we're seeing happen in Afghanistan is painful: lives lost, personal sacrifice, and anger. But that doesn't discredit or minimize what we did there. We made a commitment, and we stuck to it! We did our job—for our country and each other. Let's not let anyone or anything take that away from us."
